#### Free School Meal entitlement

Remember if you feel you may be entitled to a Free School Meal it is worth applying online at the NCC website. All you need is your national insurance number and date of birth. Whilst children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 receive a free meal under the Universal Meals scheme this ends at Year 3. However, income based Free School Meals continue beyond year 2 and also entitle you to 50% off the cost of school visits.
